2. daily futures price movements for both corn and soybeans including crop revenue guarantee prices along with the PLC price.

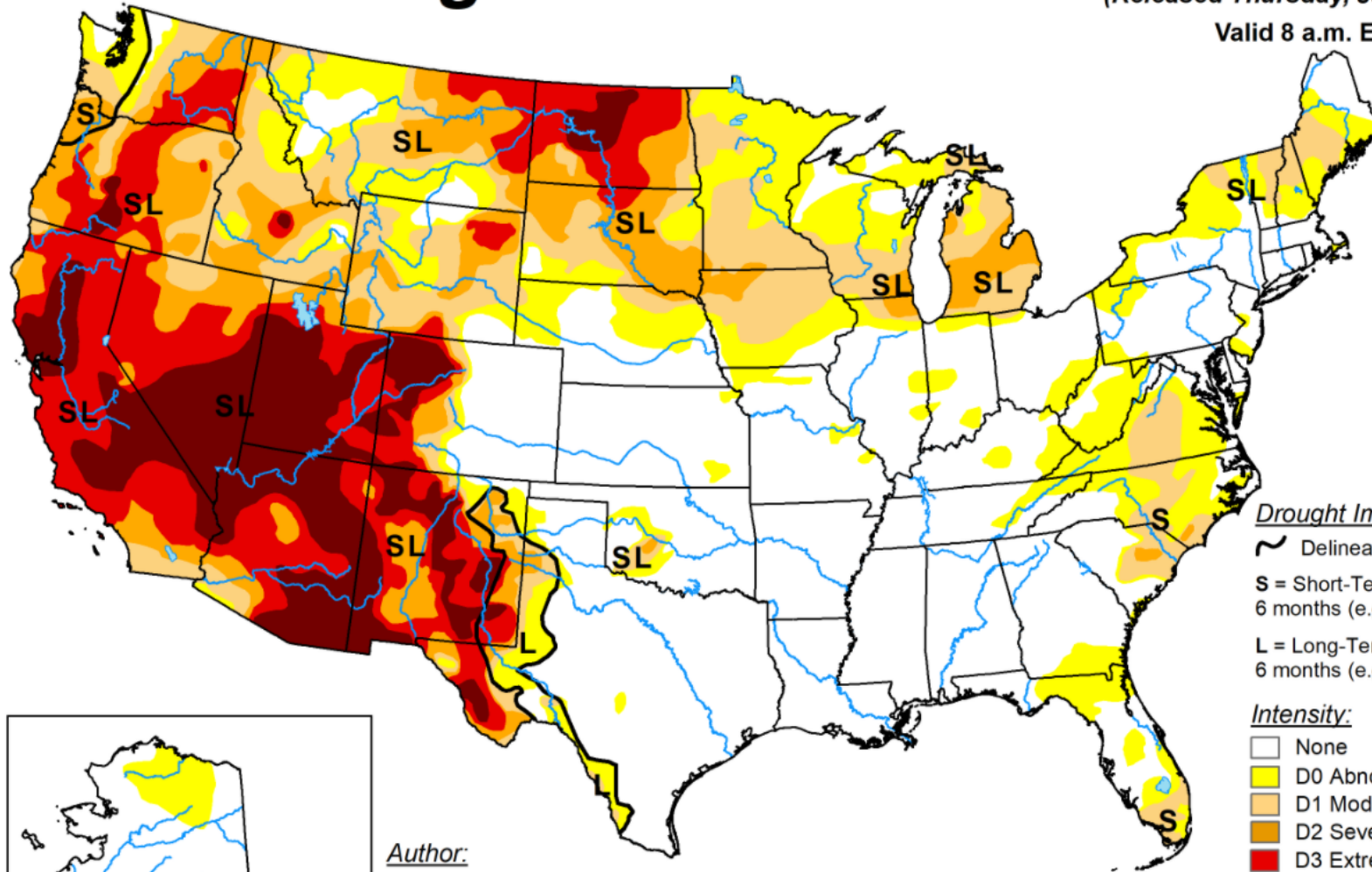

Drought Impact Types:

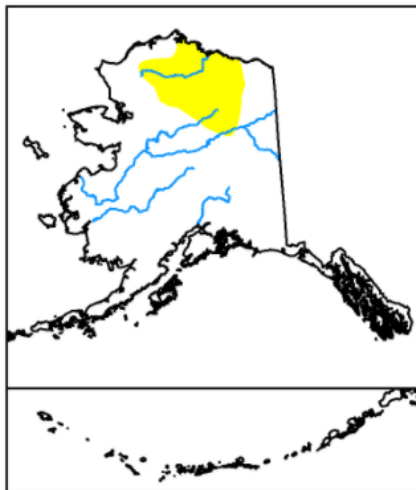
~ Delineates dominant impacts

L = Long-Term, typically greater than 6 months (e.g. hydrology, ecology)

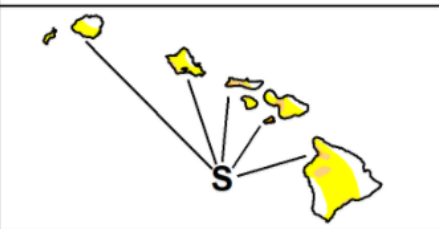
Intensity:

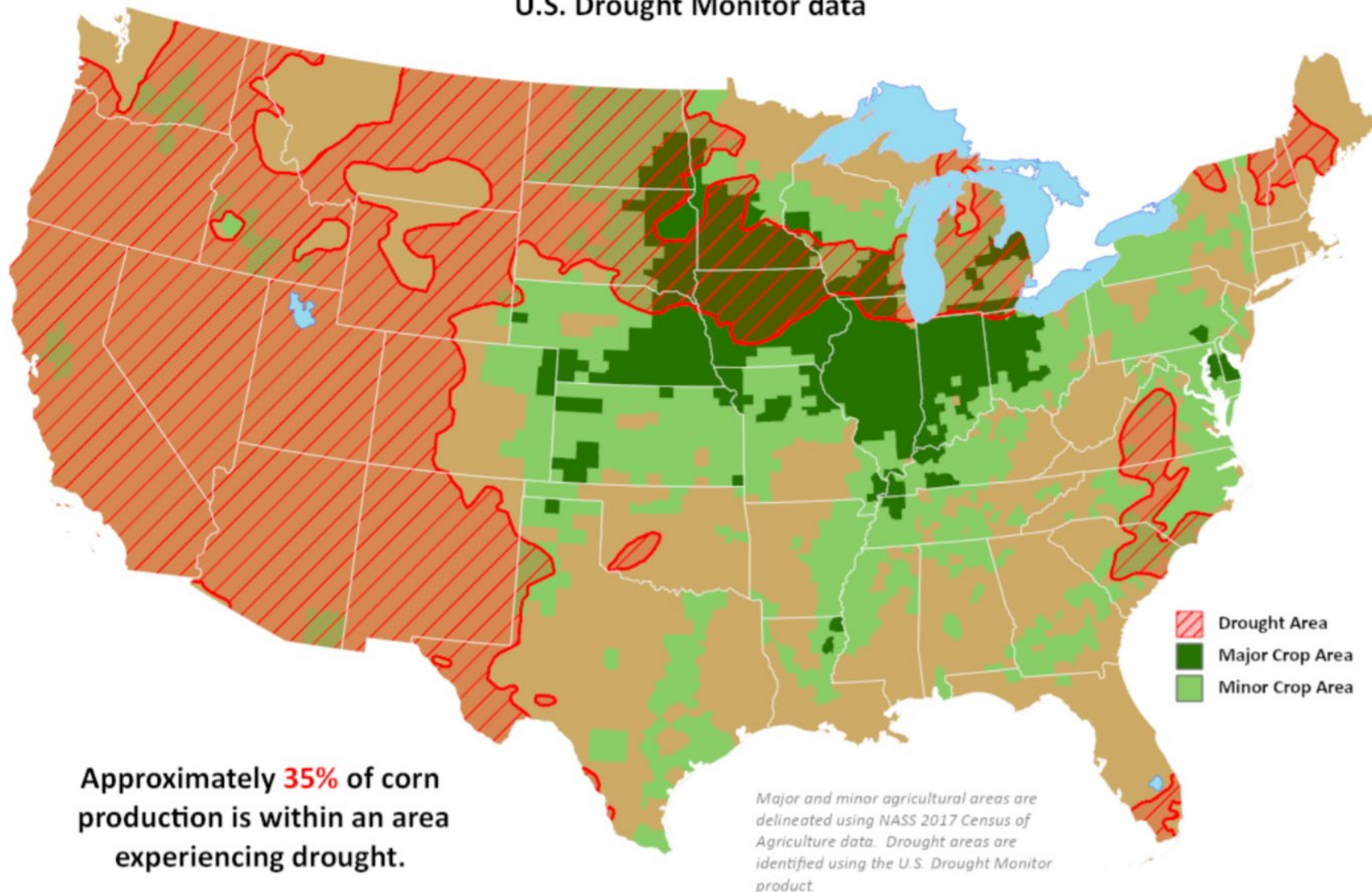

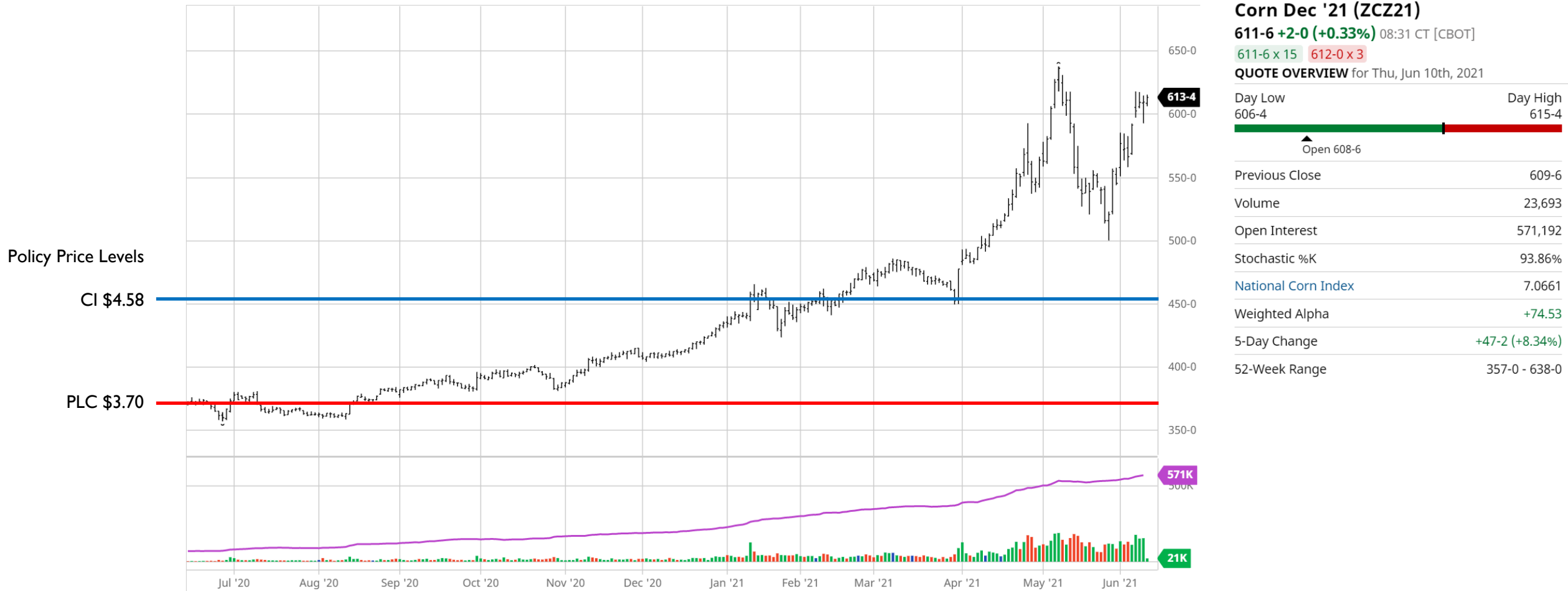

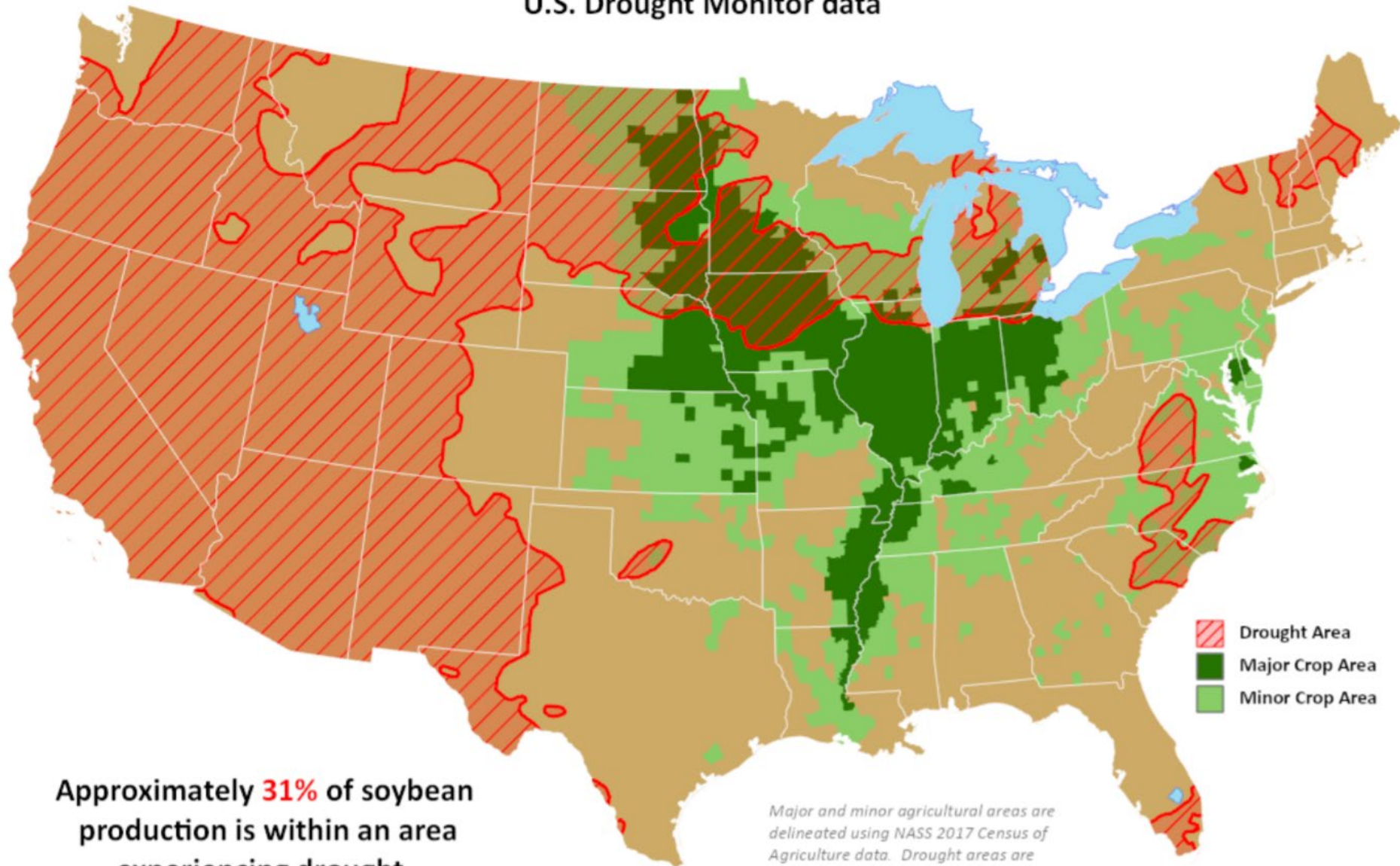

Soybean Areas in Drought

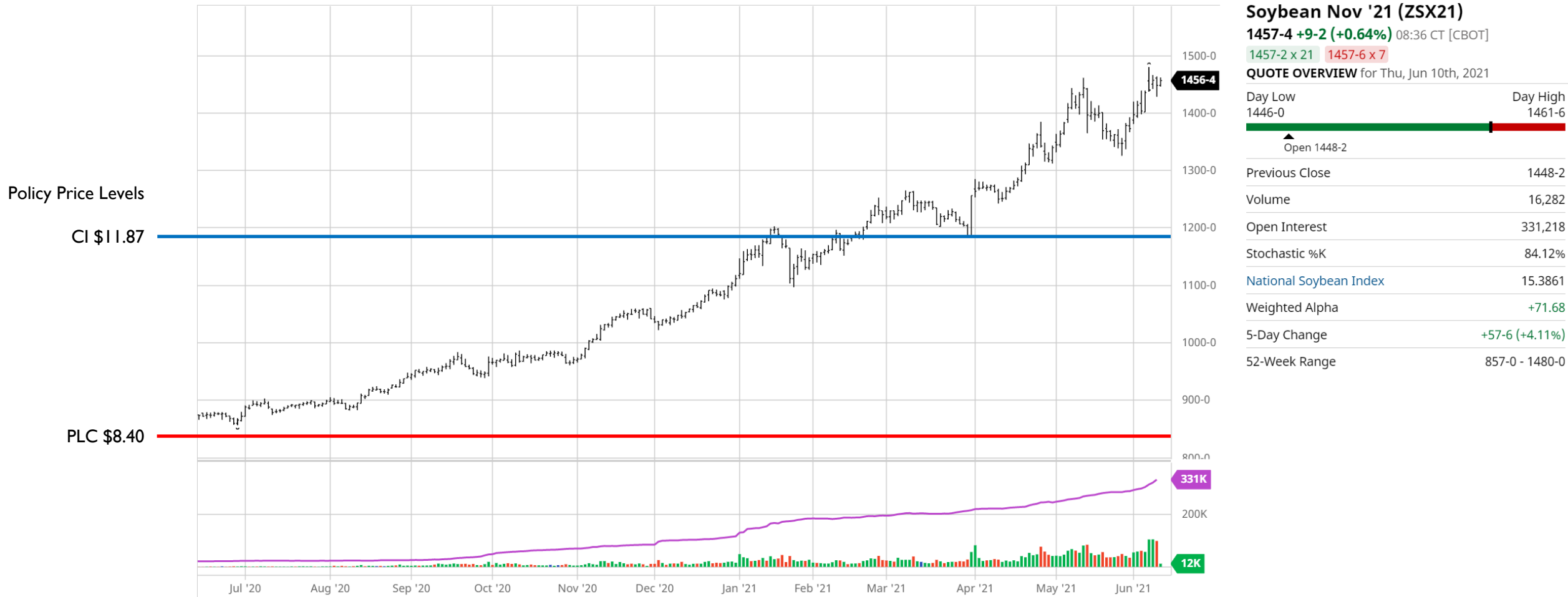
